
Environmental Management Update



Environmental Management Plans



- The plans cover initial construction activities layout including:
 - Site bulk earthworks; access roads; haul roads etc
 - Tailings storage facility; water storage dam; evaporation pond
 - Water management infrastructure
 - Accommodation camp
 - Site offices; laydown areas;
 communications; site security
 - Borrow pits; concrete batch plant
 - Borefields; surface water extraction infrastructure; water pipeline



Environmental Management Plans




- EMPs prepared in accordance with the Development Consent:
 - Content requirements
 - Consultation requirements
 - Approval requirements
- EMPs prepared for the "initial construction activities"
- EMPs will be revised for re-approval before commencement of any works after the "initial construction activities"
- Environmental Management Strategy to be prepared in consultation with CCC – provided on 25 February 2019
- Consultation period closing on Friday 22 March 2019



Environmental Management Plans

 - Road Upgrade and Maintenance Strategy




Environmental Monitoring – Air Quality Monitoring







- Dust deposition gauges installed in January 2019
- Construction phase air quality monitoring – particulate matter (PM_{2.5} and PM₁₀) and dust deposition
- Particulate matter monitoring continuous
- Meteorological monitoring continuous




Environmental Monitoring – Noise Monitoring



- Construction phase noise monitoring –
 attended monitoring conducted quarterly
- Monitoring locations defined in Environment
 Protection Licence and Noise Management
 Plan

Attended monitoring commencing 11 March
 2019 (weather permitting)



Environmental Monitoring – Water Monitoring




Surface Water
