
Project Update

Environmental Management Plans




- EMPs prepared for the "initial construction activities" and will be revised for re-approval before commencement of any works after this stage
- All EMPs submitted to the DPIE for review
- The following EMPs (incorporating Modification 4) have been approved by the DPIE:
 - Blast Management Plan
 - Road Upgrade Maintenance Strategy
 - Noise Management Plan
 - Heritage Management Plan
 - Rehabilitation Management Plan
 - Biodiversity Management Plan and Revegetation Strategy
 - Traffic Management Plan



Environmental Monitoring – Air Quality Monitoring



- Construction phase air quality monitoring – particulate matter (PM_{2.5} and PM₁₀) and dust deposition
- Dust deposition gauges
 - operating
- Real time particulate matter monitors
 - EPA approved Teledyne API T640x
 - To be installed Q4 2019
- Meteorological monitoring station
 - operating






Environmental Monitoring – Noise Monitoring




- Construction phase noise monitoring
 - quarterly attended monitoring consistent with Environment Protection Licence and Noise Management Plan
- Attended monitoring
 - conducted in June 2019; results
 demonstrated no exceedances
 - next round September 2019




Environmental Monitoring – Groundwater Monitoring



- Groundwater monitoring
 - undertaken during July
 - standing water levels from all bores
 - water quality from minesite bores
