- This work covers updating Sunrise project schedule and cost based on project development since the DFS.

- Positioning Sunrise to be ready for a final investment decision in mid-2020, subject to the completion of a financing package by that time.

Environmental Management Plans (EMPs)



- · Environmental Management Strategy has been approved
- The following EMPs (incorporating Modification 4 changes) have been approved for the initial construction activities by the DPIE:
 - Environmental Management Strategy
 - Blast Management Plan
 - Road Upgrade and Maintenance Strategy
 - Noise Management Plan
 - Heritage Management Plan
 - Rehabilitation Management Plan
 - Biodiversity Management Plan and Revegetation Strategy
 - Traffic Management Plan
- EMPs approved for the "initial construction activities" will need to be revised and reapproved by DPIE before commencement of any works after this stage
